Application & Entrance fee: \$395.00 (U.S. funds only)
Applications **MUST** include the \$395.00 fee to be considered. Faxed applications are not considered valid.

Awards: Player awards will be given to first and second place teams in U13-U19 age division. U10, U11, and U12 divisions will receive individual participation awards and one team trophy for 1st and 2nd place teams.

Rules: FIFA rules will apply to all games.

Minimum number of games: Each team will be scheduled for at least 3 games. Tournament officials reserve the right to shorten, postpone or cancel any game due to inclement weather or unplayable field conditions.

Teams and Rosters: All teams must be affiliated with their appropriate governing soccer body. Each U13-U15 team registered for the tournament will be allowed a maximum of eighteen players. U16-19 22 with 18 any one given game, U10 will be allowed 11 players and U11 and U12 will be allowed 14 players. All guest players must have a valid player pass card and a current medical release form. MSYSA guest player forms are available on line at www.msysta.net

At coach registration, coaches must present player pass cards current medical release forms, an official roster and a tournament roster.
